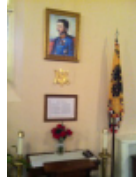




Welcome to St. Mary's Church and to the first shrine dedicated to Blessed Karl of Austria in the Washington area.

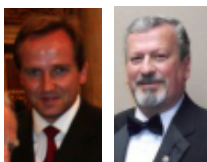

His Excellency, Don Teodoro de Faria, Bishop Emeritus of Funchal, Madeira, author of a new book about Blessed Karl. As Bishop of the diocese in which Blessed Karl died in 1922, Bishop de Faria has long been active in his cause for sainthood. It was Bishop de Faria who formally presented to the Holy Father the petition to beatify Emperor/King Karl at the beatification ceremony in Saint Peter's Square on October 3, 2004. At the reception Bishop de Faria will give a presentation about his book on Blessed Karl.
